

Alumni Report

I am writing with an update on the state of our Chapter and our Chapter House. My general message is good - we intend to recolonize the Chapter in Fall 2012 and the Chapter House is in great shape (as you can see in the photos below). I'll now fill you in regarding the details.

As I last wrote you in January 2010, the National Fraternity

revoked the Chapter's charter, after numerous unacceptable incidents. Our objective has been to (i) secure and preserve our Chapter House, and (ii) organize to recolonize the Chapter as soon as possible.

We have been successful - here is a status of our efforts to date:

- The National Fraternity has committed, and the University has agreed, to re-colonize the Chapter at the earliest opportunity which will be the Fall Semester, 2012.
- Our physical Chapter House is in great shape. We have leased our Chapter House to Phi Kappa Psi fraternity – who is taking good care of it.
- Our Housing Corporation is solvent and fiscally capable of recolonizing the Chapter in 2012.

Thank you to Tom Tedrick, Jim Smith,
Dick Graffis, Ron Kahn, Curtis Tongue,
Rob Vantress and Chris Danko for all of their
help and support. We are poised to successfully return –
now we need to build our foundation.

newsletter as the game day approaches.


